5. Understanding of basic Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) Theory relevant to a variety of lower extremity conditions the evidence based research behind it.

Instructors:

Tom Kiroplis, MSc.Ed., Dip.Ac., Dip.TCM, has been practicing Traditional Chinese Medicine since 1997 and has taught at the Institute of Traditional Chinese Medicine in Toronto since 1998. He was also vice president of the Ontario Association of Acupuncture and Traditional Chinese Medicine for many years. Tom has had intense additional training at the University of Nanjing in China, and has been teaching physical therapists Acupuncture within the physiotherapy clinic setting since 2001. As co-owner of three physiotherapy clinics, he has worked closely with physiotherapists since 1998, and chiropractors since 2015, adding a wealth of Acupuncture knowledge to many practices.

He has been learning and using acupuncture and dry needling since the beginning of his career and uses it in combination with other physiotherapy techniques with great success. In 2011, he became involved in program development and growth of the APTEI ADN course series along with other courses for Meridian Health Education. He has also enjoyed acting as a teaching facilitator for all courses since 2011 and an executive rep for the Acupuncture Division of the Canadian Physiotherapy Association since 2012. He spends time reading research literature on the effectiveness of these modalities and sharing information with his colleagues.
